#### **PREFACE**

BCRC-Egypt with the assistance of SBC organised a two days Regional training for the Arab states. The title of the training was "The Regional Training on the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS).

The main objective of the training is give the trainees the methodology on how to implement the (GHS).

The aims of the training were as follow:

- -the importance of The GHS as a tool for supporting the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions
- Overview about the GHS
- Classification Criteria for substance and mixture
- -Health Hazards
- -Environmental Hazards
- -Physical Hazards

The workshop targeted the National technical officials responsible for or involved in hazardous Waste Management. 14participants from 9Arab countries attended this workshop: Arab Republic of Egypt, Kuwait, Lebanese Republic, Palestinian Authority, the Republic of Sudan, Jordan, Mauritania and Yemen

#### **Opening session**

The session opened at 9:00am with speech by Dr.mostafa Hussein BCRC-Director who welcomed the participants from Arab countries. During his speech he mentioned the importance of the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) as a tool in the application and enforcement of the Basel ,Rotterdam, Stockholm conventions ,after that he welcomed by Dr. Saad Hassan –Head of the National Reference Laboratory for the Ministry of Environment and Former Dean of the Faculty of Science - Ain Shams University

#### **First Day:**

The first day sessions started by an overview about (GHS) system and presented a film about the importance and ways to apply the system. That was followed by lectures about classification, codes of hazardous waste and the importance of GHS. After that there was an open discussion and a distribution of an exam on the different groups of participants.
